Early College High School (ECHS) is a free public high school within the Roswell Independent School District, in partnership with Eastern New Mexico University-Roswell. Students have the opportunity to graduate from this school with a New Mexico high school diploma of excellence and up to two years of college courses or an associate's degree from ENMU-Roswell.



ABOUT EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL

The school opened in August 2014, and currently has an enrollment of 150 students. Classes are located in the Instructional Center on the campus of Eastern New Mexico University-Roswell.

School bus transportation and meals are provided. Transportation is provided through RISD school buses or public transportation. Free and reduced-priced meals are available.

ECHS is open to all RISD students who exhibit a sincere interest in academics and are willing to work hard to meet the demanding expectations of the program. Students must also be prepared to integrate into a university setting/adult environment and must be entering their freshman year.
