### • Graduation Speech (Sara Hankins)

### • Joint Advisory Boards Meeting/Strategic Planning Dinner Recap

Dr. Maguire announced that the campus has been invited to attend a meeting next Tuesday to categorize the data that was collected at the dinner. Attendees of the meeting will be divided into five groups so that each group reviews information from one of the five questions discussed at the November 29 dinner to find themes within the comments. The group will then create usable statements that will be incorporated into the strategic planning process. Dr. Maguire asked that people be encouraged to attend Tuesday's meeting. He added that information from the Listen & Learn sessions will be kept separate from this data for the time being.

#### • 2019-2020 Academic Calendar

Dr. Maguire reported that the start date and end date of the 2019-2020 academic calendar will be the same as the Portales campus. As a result, this will add a week of instruction for ENMU-Roswell. One option to counter-act this would be to have classes on the Monday of Thanksgiving, but no classes on Tuesday of that week. Another option would be to have classes on both Monday and Tuesday of Thanksgiving week. The Board of Regents have approved the campus being closed on the Wednesday of Thanksgiving week.

### • 2019-2020 Holiday Schedule

As mentioned above, the Board of Regents approved an additional holiday of the Wednesday before Thanksgiving. It is important for our campus to align with RISD. However, the State allows for a specific number of holidays. Karen will follow up and report back once she has that information. This will be discussed again at the January 2 Core Staff meeting.
