Bond B on the November 8, 2022 ballot includes a total of **\$19 million** for publicly funded academic, public, school, and tribal libraries in New Mexico. This GO Bond will provide \$6 million each for Higher Education (academic) libraries, Public libraries, and Public School libraries. It will provide \$1 million for NM Tribal libraries. The funds will be used to purchase library equipment, resource acquisitions, and information technology projects.

Unofficial amounts to be received by Roswell Public Library, academic (ENMU-Roswell and NMMI) libraries, and public school libraries (in Roswell, Dexter, Hagerman, Lake Arthur, and Sidney Gutierrez Middle School) in Chaves County are estimated to total over \$500,000.
