

# Nursing - Associate of Science



## **Program Entry Requirements:**

- Declaration of Nursing major does not guarantee entrance to the nursing program. Application process and acceptance is required.
- Completed application prior to the deadline. Application information can be found online on the <a href="ENMU-Roswell Nursing Webpage">ENMU-Roswell Nursing Webpage</a>.
- Minimum Pre-Requisite GPA of 2.75 (Calculated using only pre-requisite courses)
- Minimum Cumulative GPA of 2.0 (Calculated using all courses)
- A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses listed on the degree plan.
- Minimum total/composite score of 58.7% on the TEAS Exam. Students are allowed two attempts per application cycle; TEAS results will be accepted for one year. Recommend that students take the TEAS exam after all of the following courses have been completed (ENGL 1110, ENGL 1120, MATH, all required BIOL courses). - All pre-requisite courses must be completed.
- Students must have successfully completed a nursing assisting program, certified medical assisting program, EMT-Basic, AEMT, or Paramedic program, or have current certification with the Nurse Aide Registry.
- Current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification through the American Heart Association. (Red Cross certification is not accepted).

### **Additional Program Requirements/Information:**

- Mandatory routine and periodic drug screening will be administered throughout the nursing program.
- Nationwide FBI background checks are required for all students in the nursing program. Students must contact the nursing program director if they have a felony conviction within the last 7 years, or a misdemeanor conviction involving alcohol, drugs, or family violence within the last 3 years.
- The A.S. Nursing transfers into the RN to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at ENMU.
- Students will be required to meet all clinical requirements, which include (but not limited to) the following:
  - Current Vaccines/Immunizations (TDAP, MMR, Hepatitis B, Varicella, Flu, COVID)
  - o TB Screening (TB Skin test, Quantiferon Gold)
  - o BLS
  - Negative Drug Screen
  - Cleared Background Check
  - N-95 mask fit testing
