## Why choose OT?

Occupational therapy helps people participate in the daily activities that matter most to them. OT practitioners use creative problem-solving, hands-on strategies, and real-world support to help individuals gain independence across home, school, work, and community life.

- OTAs work under the supervision of occupational therapists to implement individualized treatment plans.
- OTAs work in hospitals, schools, clinics, rehab, home health, community and non-traditional settings.
- ENMU-Roswell's A.A.S. OTA degree can transfer into the ENMU B.A.A.S. pathway and University of New Mexico is currently in the process of developing an OTA to MOT bridge program.

## What future students want to know first

**What do I take before I apply?** See the recommended pre-admission degree map on page 3.

**Can I transfer in coursework?** Yes, but only pre-admission course work. Official transcripts are evaluated after all transcripts are received.

**When should I apply?** Apply as early as possible so your file can be reviewed and updated before Thanksgiving for the January start date.

**What if I am finishing a class now?** Use the transcript option to hold release until final grades post.

**How do I start?** Complete the university admission application, send transcripts, meet with advising, then submit the OTA application.

## Apply in 6 easy steps

### 1. Apply to ENMU-Roswell

Submit the university admission application to open your student record.

### 3. Meet with advising

Confirm course options, transfer planning, and your pre-admission semester.

### 4. Finish the support courses

Complete the recommended 16-credit pre-admission semester with a strong academic record.
