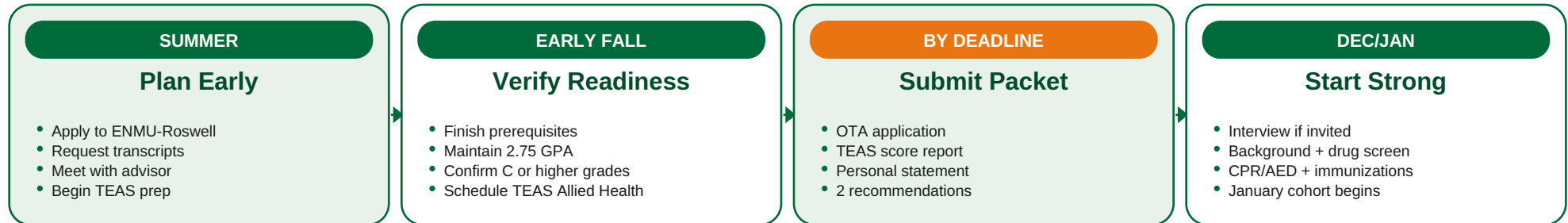

Advisor Priority: Prepare students in SUMMER and FALL for the JANUARY Spring Cohort start

Advisor Timeline: Summer -> Fall -> Spring Start



SUMMER

Plan Early

- Apply to ENMU-Roswell
- Request transcripts
- Meet with advisor
- Begin TEAS prep

EARLY FALL

Verify Readiness

- Finish prerequisites
- Maintain 2.75 GPA
- Confirm C or higher grades
- Schedule TEAS Allied Health

BY DEADLINE

Submit Packet

- OTA application
- TEAS score report
- Personal statement
- 2 recommendations

DEC/JAN

Start Strong

- Interview if invited
- Background + drug screen
- CPR/AED + immunizations
- January cohort begins

Admission Must-Haves

50%

TEAS COMPOSITE

ATI TEAS for Allied Health: Composite score of 50% or higher. Official score report required; complete within 1 year of applying.

- Minimum 2.75 prerequisite GPA
- Grade C or higher in required pre-admission courses
- Apply to ENMU-Roswell before OTA packet review
- Official high school/GED and college transcripts on file
- One-page personal statement
- Two professional recommendations - no family, relatives, or personal friends
- Interview required if invited

Advisor Course Map

Math	MATH 1130 recommended; options may include MATH 1350, MATH 1170, or MATH 1220
English	ENGL 1110; options may include ENGL 1120 or ENGL 2210
Social/Behavioral	PSYC 1110; options may include PSYC 2120 or SOCI 1110
Communication	COMM 1130; options may include COMM 2120, COMM 2140, or COMM 2150
Science	BIOL 2210 + 2210L AP I with Lab

Advisor reminder: prepare students during summer/fall, verify course currency and prerequisite GPA, and use the current catalog/degree plan for accepted options.

Hybrid + Lab Immersion

ACOTE-approved Hybrid with Required On-Campus Lab Immersion. Online coursework + required campus labs + competency validation + in-person Level I/II fieldwork. Not fully online.

Posted deadline: following Thanksgiving Break. Current Spring 2027 public deadline: Nov. 30, 2026.
