



OTA Advisor & Student Admissions Roadmap

Spring Admission Cohort | Prepare in Summer + Fall | Hybrid with Required On-Campus Lab Immersion

Students complete **TWO** applications: 1) apply to ENMU-Roswell first, then 2) submit the OTA Program application. After that, register for the ATI TEAS for Allied Health.

1 Apply to ENMU-R

University admission makes the student eligible to be reviewed for the OTA Program.

ATI TEAS for Allied Health. Composite score must be 50% or higher.

Advisor Timeline: prepare students in summer and fall

SUMMER

Apply to ENMU-R; request transcripts; start FAFSA/scholarships; begin TEAS study.

EARLY FALL

Meet advisor; verify courses, GPA, and timeline; register for TEAS Test for Allied Health.

BY NOV. 30

Submit OTA application, TEAS score, essay, transcripts, and two recommendations.

DEC/JAN

Interview if invited; complete acceptance requirements; January cohort begins.

Admission Must-Haves

50%
TEAS SCORE

ATI TEAS for Allied Health: 50% composite or higher; official score report required and completed within 1 year.

2.75+ prerequisite GPA, grade C or higher, official transcripts, one-page statement, two professional recommendations, and interview if invited.

 English: ENGL 1110; options ENGL 1120 or 2210
 Social/Behavioral: PSYC 1110; options PSYC 2120 or SOCI 1110
 Communication: COMM 1130; options COMM 2120, 2140, 2150
 Science: BIOL 2210 + BIOL 2210L
