SUMMER FINANCIAL AID REQUEST

Please read this information before submitting the summer request form.

2013 Summer and fall schedules will be available Sunday, April 7, 2013.

Are you planning to enroll in classes at ENMU Roswell for the summer session?

If so, in addition to applying for student aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you are also required to complete the ENMU Roswell Summer 2013 financial aid request form. This form allows us to collect additional information to accurately award aid for the summer. **Students must be enrolled in summer classes before the form is submitted.**

Summer financial aid is not guaranteed and is contingent on availability of funds. Completion of this form does not guarantee aid eligibility. Requests will be reviewed for Pell grant eligibility first and then campus based aid which includes SEOG and State grants and work study. All campus based aid is awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

TO APPLY FOR SUMMER FINANCIAL AID YOU MUST:

- Be enrolled in summer classes that are going toward a degree at ENMU Roswell. Students must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours to be considered for SEOG and State grants and student loans.
- Have a completed 2012-13 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file. This means your file must be complete with the Financial Aid Office.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SUMMER FINANCIAL AID YOU MUST:

- Be eligible for available campus based aid or federal grants and student loans.
- Be in compliance with the financial aid satisfactory academic progress policy (SAP). All awards
 made for summer are contingent on final SAP status after spring grades are posted.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You are responsible for paying the \$50 deposit to hold your summer classes or the classes will be dropped. Drop dates for the summer will be May 19th, May 26th, June 2nd and the final void will be on June 9th. This means if you are pre-registered in summer classes and the \$50 deposit is not made your classes will be dropped. You will have to re-enroll in classes and the same classes are not guaranteed.
- If you are in a program that will not allow you to pre-register for summer classes until spring
 grades are posted, YOU must let one of the Financial Aid or Admissions staff know when you
 submit this form.
- Students must officially withdraw from any classes he/she enrolls in that they do not plan to attend. Students will not be charged for classes dropped during the drop and add period.
- The deadline to submit student loan requests for summer will be June 20, 2013.

- Students requesting a Federal Direct Student Loan will be awarded the loan amount remaining from the current 2012-2013 award year.
- Summer aid should be awarded beginning April 22nd. Award notifications will be sent via email.
- Summer bookstore charge dates will be from May 29th to June 4th, and the first check refund date is June 14th.
- You are required to notify the Financial Aid Office of any other resource or assistance you will be receiving from any outside agencies or donors for the summer session. Ex: WIA, DVR, Tuition Waiver, Resident Assistant, scholarships, etc.
- Students must be degree seeking at ENMU Roswell in order to receive financial aid for the summer session. Consortium agreement hours from another school will be accepted for Pell grant eligibility but will not be accepted for the 6 credit hours required for campus based aid or student loans.
- If you were enrolled in another school during the 2012-13 school year and will be degree seeking and transferring to ENMU Roswell for the summer session, you will need to have an official academic transcript sent to the Admissions Office at ENMU Roswell and be fully admitted to the university.
- All correspondence is sent to students ENMU Roswell student email address so please check it on a regular basis.
