The entry level salary range is \$37,070 and a certified controller may earn up to \$139,993 depending on qualifications and location.

## Program Overview

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is looking for motivated, decisive, confident, and committed individuals who are interested in a career in aviation or a career change. Eastern New Mexico University-Roswell is one of 36 certified Air Traffic-Collegiate Training Initiative (AT-CTI) schools across America. Controllers are employed by and work directly for the FAA. The job functions include maintaining separation of aircraft, preventing collision between aircraft operating in the system, organizing and expediting the flow of traffic, and providing support for National Security and Homeland Defense.

## Program Courses

The Air Traffic Control program at ENMU-Roswell may be completed in three semesters if there has been previous college credit awarded. This will be decided on a case by case basis.
