
Why Graphic Design?

- Graphic designers find rewarding careers in specialized design services, publishing, advertising, public relations, and related services industries.

- Graphic designers use their creativity combining art and technology to develop graphics for product illustrations, logos, and websites.







Program Overview

The exciting and rapidly developing technologies, skills and applications taught within the Media Arts programs prepare students for careers in the film industry and in graphic and commercial arts, publishing, advertising, and communications. Three Media Arts tracks are available: Film Technology, Animation, and Graphic Design. Each track has two completion options:

- 1 Certificate of Employability
- 2. Associate of Applied Science

The Graphic Design track prepares students for the competitive digital production marketplace by developing artistic mastery in various areas of Media Arts. Graphic designers create visual concepts, by hand or using computer software, to communicate ideas that inspire, inform, or captivate consumers. They develop the overall layout and production design for advertisements, brochures, magazines, and corporate reports.


Completion Options
