SEQUENCE: In order to increase chances of success in more advanced courses, it is **strongly recommended** that students complete the Core 4 in the first two semesters. Courses only offered once a year are identified at the end of the course title with the following designations: **Fa** = fall only; **Sp** = spring only. NOTE: Course enrollment determines whether a course will be offered each semester.

Advisor Notes:

- In order to improve student success, all students must take the University Skills Placement Test prior to beginning the program.
- Student must have ENMU Campus System cumulative GPA of 2.0 in order to meet graduation requirements.
- In order to better prepare students for success and completion, it is strongly recommended that students complete the Core 4 and ALL Gen Ed requirements before moving into the Program Required courses.
