**SEQUENCE:** In order to increase chances of success in more advanced courses, it is **strongly recommended** that students complete the Core Course in the first two semesters. Courses only offered once a year are identified at the end of the course title with the following designations: **Fa** = fall only; **Sp** = spring only. NOTE: Course enrollment determines whether a course will be offered each semester.

**Advisor's Notes/Recommendations:**

Early Childhood Education students may pursue a Certificate of Occupational Training in the areas of Early Childhood Education. ENMU-Roswell's ECE certificate of Occupational training is a 32 credit hour concentration program consisting of the early childhood education courses found in the Associate of Science Degree.
