Review of January 25, 2021 Core Team Meeting Notes

La Casa Contract

Discussions are ongoing with La Casa to develop a current contract for medical and behavioral health services.

Child Development Center

Dr. Powell, Mr. Major, and Ms. Oracion will meet with the Executive Director of Family Resource and Referral tomorrow to discuss the operating agreement for the Child Development Center. It would be beneficial to have a 24-hour child development program.

Legislative Update

A record number of bills are being filed this year. House Bill 212 would allow for NMSU-Carlsbad to become an independent community college with the proposed name of Southeast New Mexico College.

Monthly Campus Discussions via Teams

The monthly campus-wide discussions will be reinstated virtually this spring utilizing Microsoft Teams in an effort to keep communication open with campus. The February meeting will be scheduled for this Friday, February 12 at 10:00 am to share employment opportunities coming available on campus. The Facebook Live sessions will continue, as well.

Social Media Coordinator

ENMU-Ruidoso is tentatively interested in sharing a Social Media Coordinator position. Ms. Oracion and Ms. Oldfield will discuss the position in detail to develop the job description and appropriate reporting structure.

Organizational Changes

Special Services will be aligned under Technical Education. Ms. Oldfield is visiting with Adult Education to determine the best reporting structure for that area. Executive Directors and At-Will employees will be discussed at the next Core Team meeting.

Additional Topics

ECHS is scheduled to be back on campus February 22, and Ms. Oldfield is working with them regarding their reopening plans. Youth Challenge will not be back before July.

Ms. Oracion is working with the Multicultural Affairs office at ENMU-Portales to coordinate virtual Black History events.

It is unknown at this time whether spring graduation will be virtual or in-person. Dual scenarios are being developed. The graduation group will meet soon to discuss in-person venue options and the necessary timeline for determining the graduation format. The PAC will likely be unavailable due to renovations. The Wool Bowl may be a good outdoor venue because it would allow appropriate social distancing.
