The Technical Education unit provides students with the opportunity to complete a variety of degrees and certificates to prepare them for rewarding careers throughout Southeast New Mexico and beyond.

Students will find program opportunities including: an Accounting and Bookkeeping Certificate of Occupational Training (COT); an Associate of Arts (AA) in Agriculture; a Snap-On certified Automotive Technology program; an FAA approved Part 147 Aviation Maintenance Technology program; a Business Administration AA degree; a Commercial Driving License (CDL) training program; a Computer and Information Technology program; a Criminal Justice AA degree; an Engineering and Design Technology program; an HVAC Excellence accredited Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Technology program; Industrial Engineering Technology program; a Media Arts program with concentrations in Animation, Film Technology, and Graphic Design; An Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Police Science; a Professional Pilot Training program for fixed wing aircraft; an Occupational Safety Engineering and Environmental Management Technologies program; and an American Welding Society (AWS) certified Welding Technology program.
