

ENMU-Roswell Year-Round Pell and Summer Financial Aid Information

New/High School Students

Summer Pell Grant is based on the previous semesters' FASFA application. New students and entering High School graduates can complete and submit the 2017-2018 FAFSA and possibly receive Pell Grant funds.

Continuing Students Full-time Fall 2017 *and* Spring 2018

If a current student already has received the Pell Grant based on full-time enrollment during the previous Fall *and* Spring semesters, the student may be eligible for an additional 50% of Pell Grant funds to be disbursed during summer, based on at least half-time enrollment status (6+ hrs.) and academic progress.

Continuing Students Less than Full-time Fall 2017 *and/or* Spring 2018

If a current student already has received the Pell Grant based on less than full-time enrollment during the previous Fall and Spring semesters, any unused funds remaining from Fall and Spring can be disbursed during summer, based on their enrollment status and academic progress.

Other Summer Aid Information

Summer Financial Aid Request Forms will be available online once Summer registration opens in April.

Students who are interested in State grant funds, work-study or student loans should submit a summer request form (students must be registered before submitting a request form).
