Awards will be made to students who meet award criteria, based on a student essay explaining scholarship need. Five awards of \$1,000 each are available.

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Age 16 or older**
- **Resident of New Mexico and the United States**
- **Member of NMAAA (<http://www.nmaaa.net/join-us>)**
- **Enrolled in aviation courses or on aviation career path**

Application Requirements:

- **Complete this Application**
- **Submit a 500-word essay, double spaced, to explain why you are choosing Aviation as your chosen career path**
- **Submit unofficial transcripts showing a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale**
- **Proof of New Mexico residence (a New Mexico school transcript will suffice)**
